Advocating for structural reforms and a culture of excellence within the academic sector.



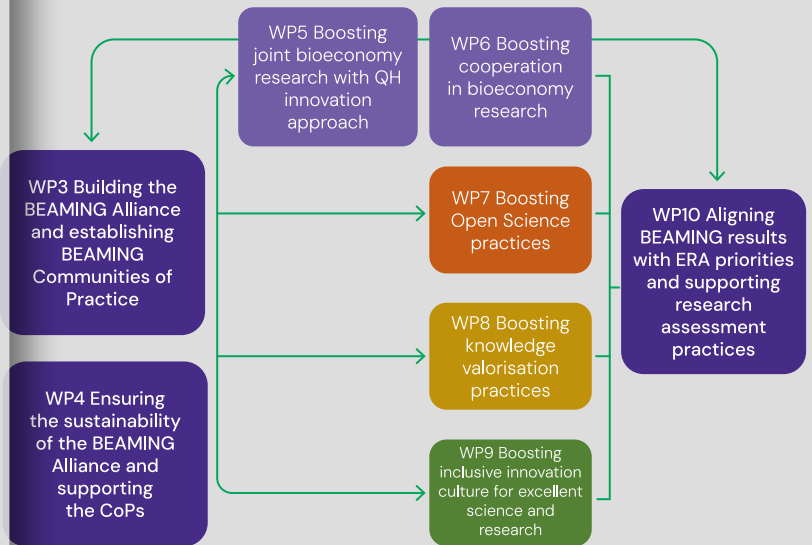
Enhancing innovation capacity and practical application of research results through the Quadruple Helix innovation ecosystem approach.



Facilitating international collaboration and knowledge transfer to strengthen research capabilities in countries with low R&D performance.

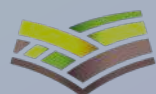
